



Many miraculous things are happening here. I am excited to share just a few with you. In a few days, Wes, CJ and I had the privilege of seeing Diane lead 14 people to the Lord. It is amazing to see people's eyes opened to the gospel and to Jesus' saving grace at work. They were once blind, but now they can see.

One such story is about Maria. Maria came to the church in complete despair. Her husband is a survivor of Chernobyl and he now has diabetes and both of his legs have been amputated. She cares for him all day. The government will not give them a wheelchair. I can't imagine this. Maria's daughter died 6 months ago and she is now taking care of her 14 year old grandson. But her one year old granddaughter is in an orphanage, because it is too much for her to take care of both children and her husband. When Diane talked to Maria about Jesus and His greatest gift of salvation, understanding flooded over her. CJ and I could see her countenance change. After she asked Jesus into her heart, she said, 'I feel so much joy and peace now.'
